



Advanced Placement (AP) Credits

Advanced Placement: Coe College grants college credit for Advanced Placement (AP) examination scores of 4 or 5. Each AP exam may earn 1.0 course credit, unless specified otherwise in the table below, for a maximum of eight course credits towards graduation. Credit is granted for a particular course or towards graduation, as indicated in the following table, upon receipt of the results of the examination, which must be received directly from the Educational Testing Service. AP credit cannot be used to fulfill any general education requirement, including First-Year Seminar, distribution requirements, Diverse Cultural Perspectives, or academic practicum, *regardless if it is granted towards a particular course which otherwise would.*
