Emergency Alert System Cell phone text messaging registration procedure

Effective August 2017

Coe College has contracted with a service provider, Rave Mobile Safety, to provide cell phone text messages as part of the Emergency Alert System. To receive official text messages from the college, students, faculty and staff are strongly encouraged to register on the Rave website. The entire sign-up process will take less than one minute.

For first-time users:

- 1) Launch www.getrave.com/login/coe
- 2) Click on the "Register" link on the page.
- 3) Follow the steps for creating your Coe Emergency Alert System Account

For users who signed up for text messaging during previous school years:

- 1) Launch www.getrave.com/login/coe
- 2) Enter user name and password you used previously to be sure your information is up-to-date.
