Update: Campus Community and COVID-19

Currently there are 13 positive students and 15 total students are in quarantine or isolation. 3 faculty or staff members have tested positive and in the isolation period.

Numbers of students in quarantine or isolation are updated twice per week on the [Coe website](#).

Update: Vaccination Booster Registration and Clinics

Vaccination rates continue to be very encouraging and are outlined below. For boosters, 40% of our faculty and staff have registered their booster, and 20% of students have done so. If you haven't yet, please take a moment to [register](#) your card and update vaccine information. We will continue to report numbers as we have them available and we will host another vaccine/booster clinic over the next couple of weeks so look for that information from Wellness.

Reminder: Testing Resources

- Health Services will schedule a rapid antigen test for symptomatic students, and close contacts (without symptoms) or those who want to test for safety will take a PCR test that will go to a lab within 24 hours.

Reminder: Masking and Q/I Policies

Faculty may report students who aren't wearing masks properly to the Associate Dean for Student Academics as an academic policy violation.

This [document](#) is a visual representation of the reporting policy and quarantine/isolation protocols. As a reminder, it is a conduct violation to attend classes if you have tested positive, or if you are a close contact and have symptoms. Students who test positive, or who are a close contact who develop symptoms, must report this information to covid@coe.edu immediately and isolate to the best of their ability until a COVID response team member reaches out with instructions.

Reminder: Community Benchmarks

Below are the benchmarks the COVID Leadership committee is monitoring:

- The **Coe community positive rate** continues to be under 1%.
- The Coe community has surpassed 85% **vaccination rate** in the student population and 94% for faculty and staff.
- The CDC continues to list **Linn County** as a high risk for transmission.
- **Hospital capacity** is listed as red (closed for transfers and limited capacity).

The Health Services clinic offers a wide range of services to Coe students, which includes free and confidential STI testing.
