Campus Community and COVID-19

Our community experience with COVID-19 remains very low and we are grateful. Today there is 1 student who tested positive in isolation, and 5 additional students in quarantine. There is one faculty or staff member who tested positive and is in isolation.

Numbers of students in quarantine or isolation are updated twice per week on the [Coe website](#).

Vaccination Information:

Coe College vaccination rates continue to climb and we couldn't be happier about it. As of today:

- 81% of our students are fully vaccinated.
- 83% of students have had at least one dose of vaccine.
- 93% of faculty and staff are fully vaccinated.
- 95% of full time faculty and staff are fully vaccinated.
- 98% of full time faculty are fully vaccinated.
