Abstract: Conger Metcalf was an esteemed artist and professor at Boston University's School of Fine Arts. He lived from 1914 to 1998. During his prime years he created many artworks that are now all over the United States, including Boston, Massachusetts; Cedar Rapids, Iowa; and Phoenix, Arizona. This collection includes audio cassettes of interviews with him as well as the transcripts, a video recording of a drawing lesson he conducted, and a folder dedicated to newspaper clips, invitations to his galleries, eulogies, and personal notes.
