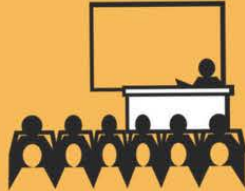


PRESENTING IN 6 GROUPS

SYMPOSIUM



Group divides content into more or less equal parts. Each group member presents one part of topic. Roughly same amount of time is given to each subtopic.

PANEL



Interactive format in which a moderator poses questions or makes statements to group and each member discusses for a short time. Purpose is to have a discussion in front of audience.

DEBATE



Pro/con, either/or presentation within the group. Can have a moderator which seeks to summarize and find common ground between arguments.

COLLOQUIUM



Panel presentation where members of the audience have a chance to interact with panel. Panelists make opening statements, audience members ask questions, make statements, argue.



GROUP SPEAKING TIPS

- Prepare together before presenting.
- Remember you're presenting the entire time.
- Present together cohesively. Transition.
- Have backups.
