

# Financial Aid/ Student Accounts Timeline

## Dates to Remember

**August 1, 2019:** Payment is due for semester payment plans and the first Monthly Payment Plan installment is due. Billing statements are always available on my.coe.edu provided that your student has set up Parent Portal access.

**August 13, 2019:** This marks the first day we can credit student accounts with “real” financial aid. The July, August and December billing statements reflect estimated funding. Financial Aid will only be credited beginning August 14 provided that verification of FAFSA (if applicable) is complete, tax filing status is updated and Entrance Interviews and Master Promissory Notes (MPN) for federal and/or institutional loans are completed.

**August 17, 2019:** Payroll paperwork (for work study or other student employment) can be completed during orientation check-in.

**August 22, 2019:** Work study (for those awarded) orientation session for students. Get the answers to all your questions about the work study program.

**August 23, 2019:** Classes begin for fall term. A student is now considered officially enrolled at Coe College. The student educational record including billing and financial aid information transfers to the student. From this point on unless the student has specifically designated access to the parent on the Coe College Parent Portal (available on my.coe.edu) college officials will not be allowed to discuss any aspect of the student educational record including financial aid and student accounts with anyone other than the student.

**October 1, 2019:** On or after this date, you must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to apply for financial aid for the 2020-21 academic year if you wish to reapply for federal/state financial aid or Coe need based aid. To ensure prompt processing and data accuracy, we recommend that you file FAFSA via the web at <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/>.

Upon receipt of a processed FAFSA our office will notify the student that the FAFSA has been received (not before November 15). If the application has been selected for verification of by the federal processor we will notify the student by sending a letter home with a request for the appropriate documents.

**October 10, 2019:** The first student pay date (provided the student turned in hours for the previous month). Payment will be credited to the student account or directly deposited to the student’s bank account.

Student payroll will continue to be paid the 10<sup>th</sup> of each month (or the closest business day) during the academic year.

**November 2019:** Registration for spring 2020 classes takes place. The student account must be current (work study payments/monthly payment plans) or paid in full in order to register for classes.

**December 2019:** Spring billing statements will be available on my.coe.edu in mid-December. Email notifications will be sent to students coe.edu email address and parents at their email as provided with the Parent Portal registration process.

# Financial Aid/ Student Accounts Timeline

## Dates to Remember

**January 10, 2020:** Payment is due for the spring semester for both the semester payment plan and the monthly payment plan. Please note: You must sign up for the monthly payment plan EACH semester.

**January 2020:** The Business Office will issue a 1098T in mid to late January.

**March 1, 2020:** Coe College PRIORITY DEADLINE. You should file your 2020-21 FAFSA on or before this date in order to receive priority consideration for financial aid funds. Failure to file your FAFSA by the deadline may result in reduction or loss of federal, state and Coe need based grants, work study awards and low interest loans.

**April 2020:** Registration for Fall 2021 classes takes place. The student account must be current (work study payments/monthly payment plans) or paid in full in order to register for classes.

**June 2020:** Notification of 2020-21 financial aid awards will begin for all continuing students who have completed the administrative requirements noted above. Awards are sent to the student Coe email address.

**July 1, 2020:** Iowa residents must file a FAFSA on or before this date to be considered for the Iowa Tuition Grant.

**July 2020:** Fall 2020 billing statements will be available on [my.coe.edu](http://my.coe.edu)

If you are applying for Parent (PLUS) loans or private loans we strongly suggest that you have the process completed by the end of July.
