An advocate from the Riverview Center, **Nora Heaton, will be on-campus today from 1-3 p.m. and is available to meet with students. Nora will be working out of the Reflection Room in Upper Gage (across from the LGBTQ Resource Center).** If you need assistance in locating the Reflection Room, please stop at the front desk in Student Life. Staff from Student Life can show you to the Reflection Room.

As a reminder, the [Riverview Center](#) is a nonprofit agency committed to providing compassionate, client-centered care for individuals affected by sexual misconduct in Iowa. The Riverview Center is staffed with trained, experienced advocates. [As the Riverview Center explains](#), "Advocates support survivors during legal proceedings and medical exams and help connect survivors with the resources they require to meet their basic needs because we understand trauma can impact every facet of an individual's life. It is their legal right, as the survivor of a crime, to have an advocate by their side as they navigate the criminal justice system. Riverview Center can also accompany the survivor to the hospital, should they decide to receive medical care following sexual abuse or assault. Advocates provide information for survivors for all available options and never push survivors toward a certain plan of action. From standing with survivors in the courtroom to finding safe housing, advocates are client-centered in everything they do."
