Getting a flu shot can lessen the risk of severe influenza and also lessened the severity of illness. A flu vaccine this season can also help reduce the burden on our healthcare systems and on campus quarantine system in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Our first flu clinic will take place on **Monday, September 20th, from 9am-12pm**. Get signed up and start protecting yourself, your loved ones and the campus community as soon as possible!

### Flu Vaccine Clinic Dates\*

**Monday, September 20 9am- noon**

**Friday, September 24 10am-4pm**

**Tuesday, September 28 9am-1pm**

**Thursday, September 30 1pm-4pm**

\*If these dates are filled, additional dates may be released

**Location:** Our vendor, Hy-Vee will utilize a mobile bus to complete the vaccination process. The Healthy You mobile will be parked in the loading zone outside the ARC for the duration of the clinics.

### What do I need to do?

- Sign up for a time through this [link](#).
- Bring your health insurance card (or a copy of your card) for our vendor to bill your insurance.
- Wear a face covering during your appointment.
- Print and complete the attached [consent form](#) to give to the staff member at check-in.
- **Plan to bring a photo ID, insurance card or \$35 cash and consent form to your appointment.**

### Do I need to bring any money to my appointment?

Flu vaccines are generally covered at 100% under preventive care. For individuals who do not have access to health insurance or do not wish to use insurance, you may bring \$35 cash to the clinic and obtain a vaccine without insurance.

### What if I don't have insurance or the financial resources to pay for the vaccine?

Coe supplies are extremely limited so you should sign up above if you have insurance or financial means to receive the vaccine. However, if you do not have health insurance and have financial concerns, please complete [this form](#) and Coe will reach out to help coordinate a reduced or low cost option for you.
