International Baccalaureate: Coe College credit may be awarded for International Baccalaureate work. Students may earn 1.0 course credit for each higher level examination score of 5, 6, or 7 to a maximum of eight course credits. No credit is granted for standard level examinations. Students may not receive college credit for both AP and IB in areas of similar content. Credit is granted for credit towards graduation or for particular courses as indicated in the table below, upon receipt of the results of the examination, which must be received directly from IB. IB credit cannot be used to fulfill any general education requirement, including First-Year Experience, Divisional Requirements, Diversity Across the Curriculum, Writing Across the Curriculum, or Practicum.
