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## **Mandatory Fees Information**

### **Student Activity Fee**

The student activity fee is assessed on all Coe students by a vote of Student Senate. The fee provides funding to support the multitude of activities and student organizations available to Coe students. The Business Office collects the fee and disburses it to Student Senate to fund programs approved by that body.

### **Health Fee**

The student health fee gives students access to essential physical and mental health services, public health initiatives and wellness activities provided by the college.
