

### **Current Activity**

The knowledge rate of the Class of 2021 is 91.6% (251 of 274 graduates). There is no information available for 8.4% of the class. Percentages reported here reflect the knowledge rate of the college, not the total graduating class.


- 95.26% of respondents reported engagement in productive post-graduation activity such as employment, graduate/professional school, scholarship/fellowship, or military.
- 2.79% of respondents reported that they were still seeking employment or graduate programs six months after graduation.





#### **Employment**

- 94% of respondents who were working reported employment in full-time positions.
- Slightly over 1/4 of the graduates (28.57%) entering the workforce reported a salary on the survey. The 41.49% of respondents who did share salary information reported an annual salary at \$40,000 or higher.
- The most commonly-reported employment fields were Business (30.8%), Health & Science (25.8%), and Education & Training (18%).




#### **Annual Salary Range**


This was an optional question; these figures represent 52 members of the Class of 2021 who chose to report their salary information in the survey.



### **Post-Graduation Residence**

- 50% of the those reporting post-graduate residence in the Class of 2021 reported staying in lowa to live, work or go to graduate/professional school
- 73% of those choosing to reside in Iowa are living and working in the Creative Corridor (Cedar Rapids/Iowa City area).



C3: Creativity, Careers, Community collected and compiled information about the post-graduation activities of the Class of 2021 within 6-9 months of graduation. We gained knowledge of 251 of the 274 total graduates (approximately 92% of the class) through the Senior Survey (May 2021), the First Destination Survey (Dec 2021), or through sources such as social networking websites and information from Coe faculty and staff.
