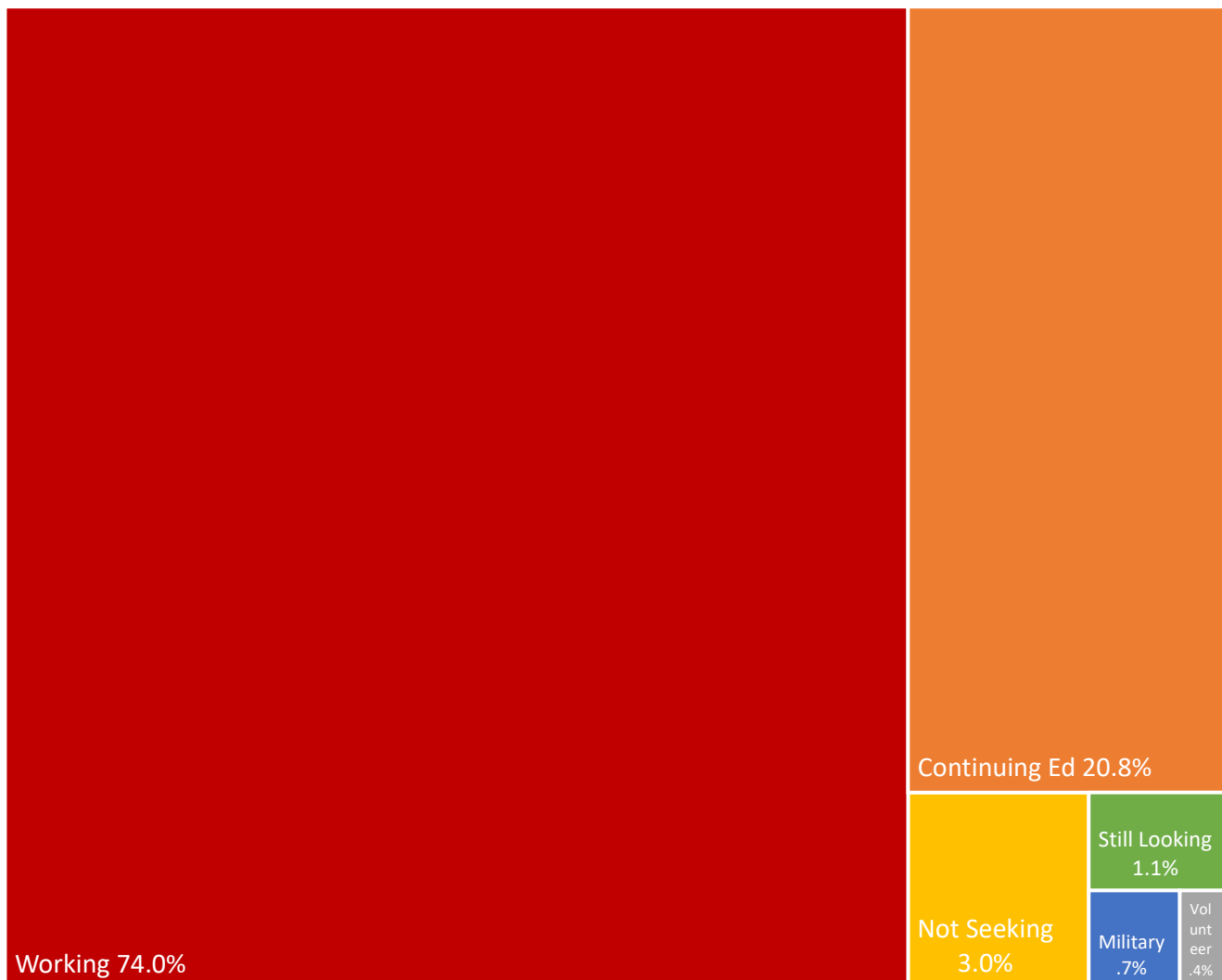
**First Destination Report**

## Current Activity

The knowledge rate of the Class of 2022 is 90.3% (269 of 298 graduates). There is no information available for 9.7% of the class. Percentages reported here reflect the knowledge rate of the college, not the total graduating class.

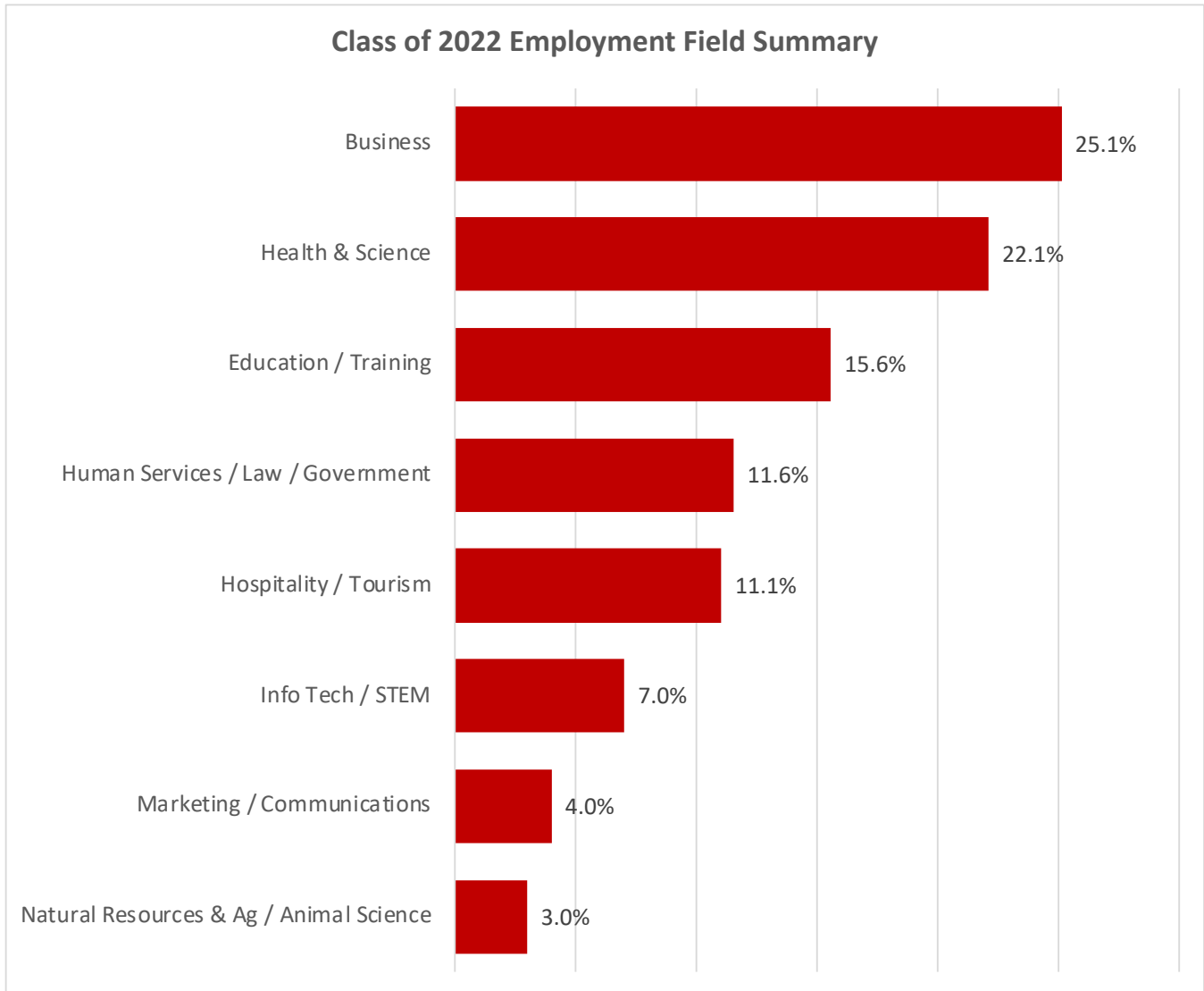
- 95.9% of respondents reported engagement in productive post-graduation activity such as employment, graduate/professional school, scholarship/fellowship, or military.
- 1.1% of respondents reported that they were still seeking employment or graduate programs six months after graduation.
- 3% of respondents have decided not to work or seek out employment, nor continue their education or enter the military.

## Employment

- 90.5% of respondents who were working reported employment in full-time positions.
- The most commonly reported employment fields were Business (25.1%), Health & Science (22.1%), & Education & Training (15.6%).



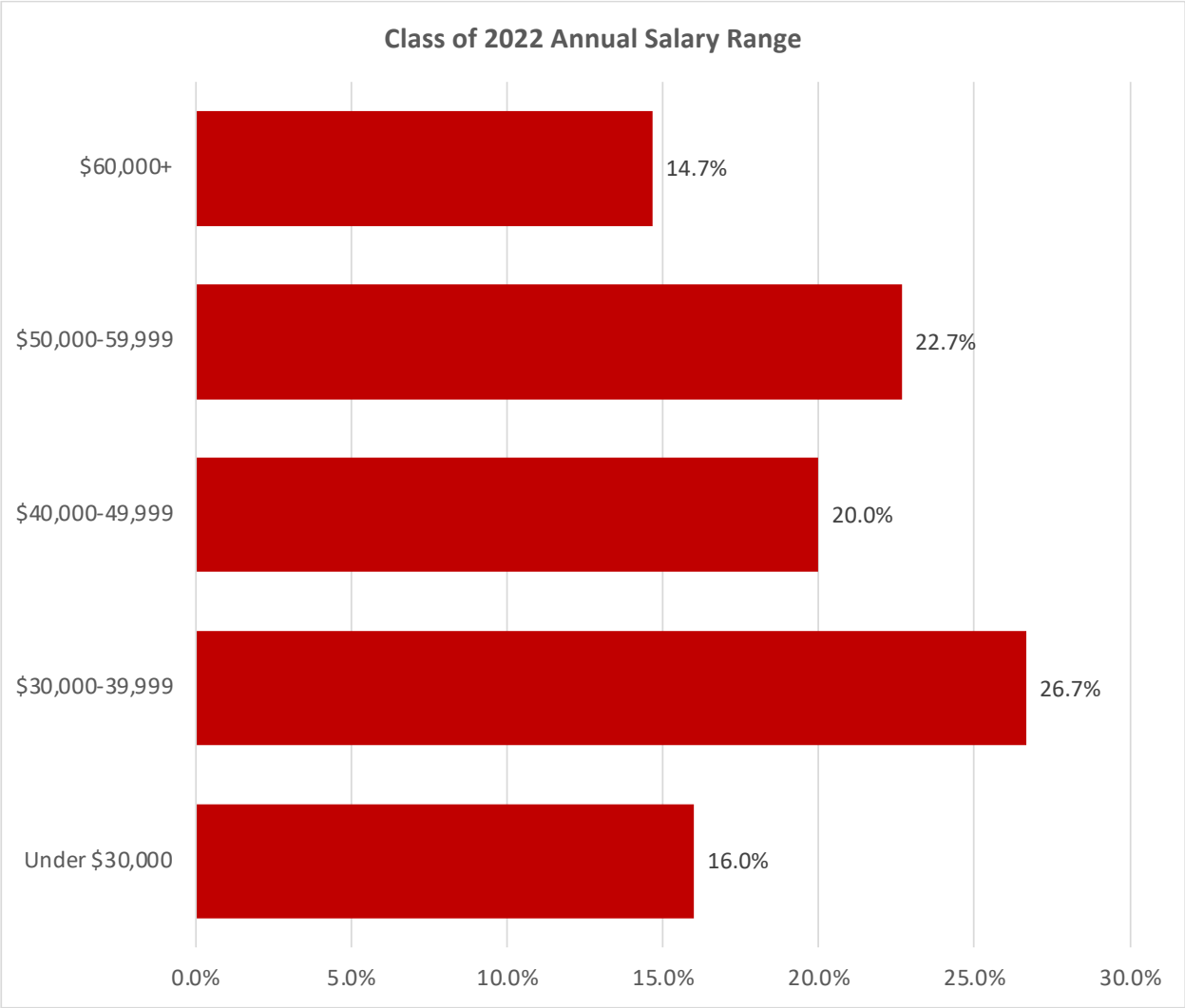

This was an optional question; these figures represent 75 members of the Class of 2022 (37.8%) who chose to report their salary information in the survey.

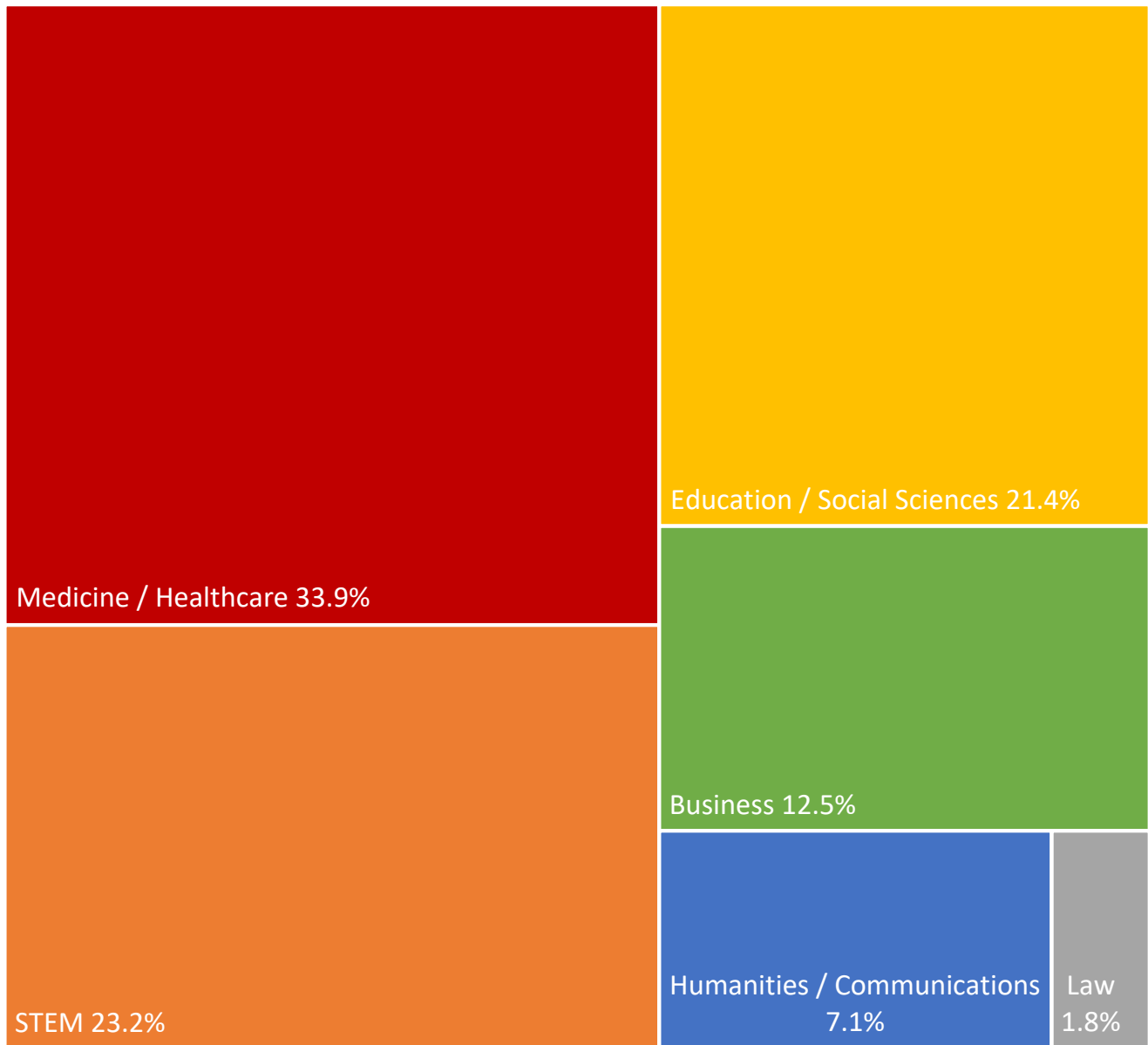
- The average annual reported was \$42,961.

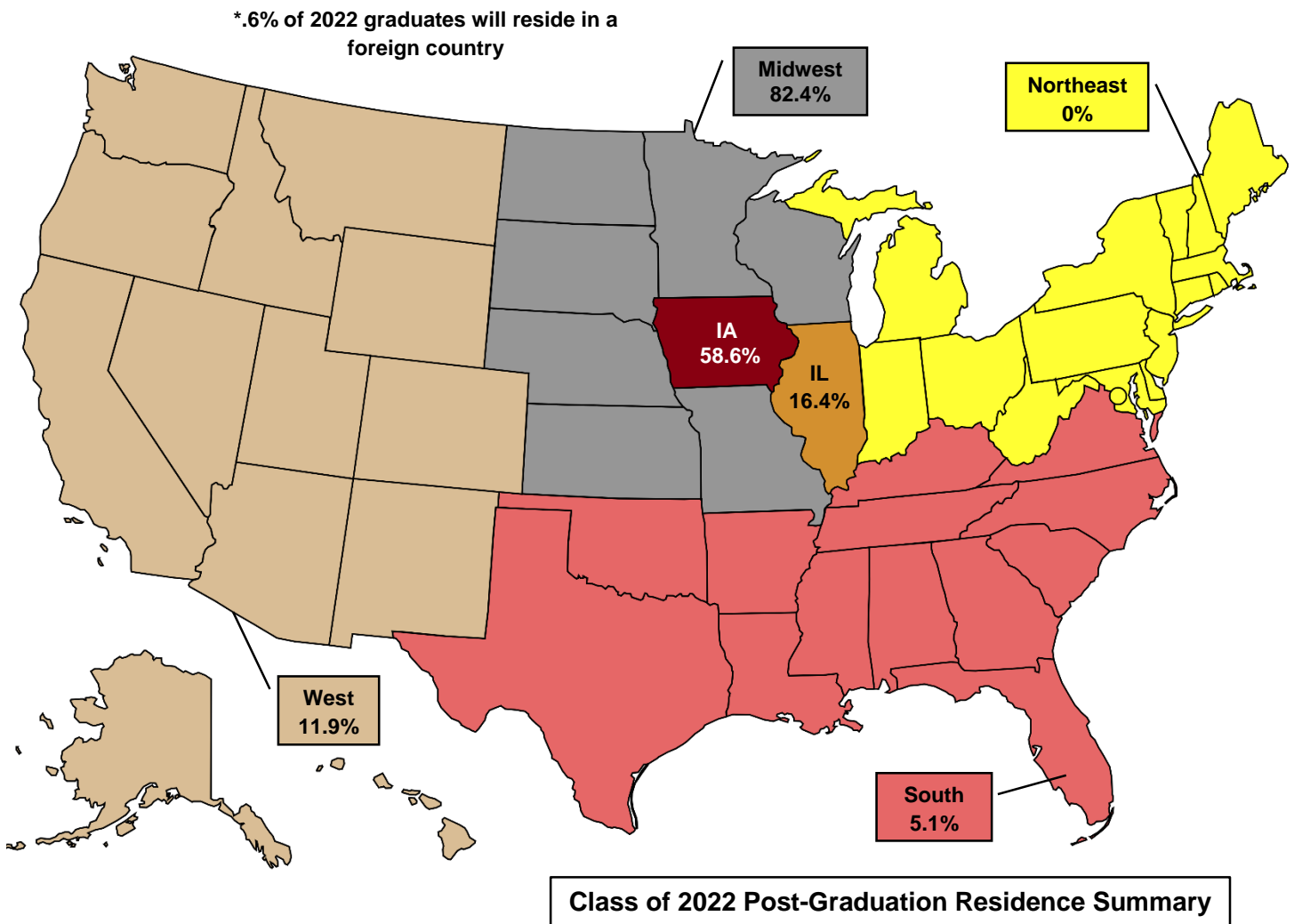

## Post-Graduation Residence

- 58% of the those reporting post-graduate residence in the Class of 2022 reported staying in Iowa to live, work or go to graduate/professional school
- 72.5% of those choosing to reside in Iowa are living & working in the Creative Corridor (Cedar Rapids/Iowa City area).





C3: Creativity, Careers, Community collected & compiled information about the post-graduation activities of the Class of 2022 within 6-9 months of graduation. We gained knowledge of 269 of the 298 total graduates (90.3% of the class) through the Senior Survey (May 2022), the First Destination Survey (Dec 2022), or through sources such as social networking websites & information from Coe faculty & staff.
