THINGS TO DO & SEE

CONCERTS, SPORTING EVENTS AND MORE

Hit up the U.S. Cellular Center for concerts, sporting events and visiting speakers, or check out the McGrath Amphitheatre for community programs and nationally ticketed touring events, the McGrath Amphitheatre is your go-to spot for live summer entertainment.

FOR THE SPORTS JUNKIE

Take advantage of biking and walking trails that wind throughout downtown Cedar Rapids and along the Cedar River. Cheer on the Kernels — our minor-league baseball team, the RoughRiders — a U.S. Hockey League team, the Cedar Rapids Rollergirls or the River Kings — Cedar Rapids' indoor arena football team.

FRESH AND LOCAL

The NewBo City Market, located in the heart of the New Bohemia District, is a year-round indoor farmers' market made up of dozens of local vendors and food providers. You'll find everything from brick-oven pizza to old-fashioned ice cream and internationally flavored cuisine.

HISTORY AND CULTURE

MUSEUMS: The National Czech and Slovak Museum and Library, Cedar Rapids Museum of Art and the African American Museum of Iowa are all located within a few miles of campus.

THEATER: Within walking distance you'll find Theatre Cedar Rapids, the local community theater, boasting over a dozen productions each year in addition to visiting acts. A few blocks farther you'll find Paramount Theatre, host to Orchestra Iowa and entertainment events.

THE GO-TO FOR READING LOVERS

The Cedar Rapids Downtown Public Library is a great spot for some quiet, casual reading. Be sure to visit the top floor of the building and check out the eco-friendly green roof!
