Off-Campus Federal Work Study Overview

The Basics:

- Must be eligible for Federal Work Study as part of your financial aid package
- Earn Work Study Award while serving with a local non-profit
- Student must secure a position on their own, but our office works with you to find a good fit

Securing a Position:

- Meet with C3 staff to discuss your interests, skills, schedule, and availability. We'll recommend a few sites that may be a good fit and provide you with contact information if necessary.
- It is up to you to secure your position! Most organizations have online applications and an interview process.
- We cannot guarantee you will get a position, but it is likely if you put in the time and effort

Other Information:

- Work study is only available during the academic year. Once finals end, so does work study.
- OCFWS employers are labeled in Handshake. You can view these by clicking on Jobs, then Employers. Use the filters on the left side of the screen and scroll down until you see "Labels". Start typing "ocfws site" to bring up possible sites.
- We do have the ability to add new sites. Have something specific in mind but don't see it listed? Just let C3 know and we'll reach out!

Things to Consider:

- Location many are close to campus, but make sure to know what is realistically walkable or drivable for you, and the time that it may take to travel to/from
- You represent Coe as you are serving off campus but also the agency. Please act professionally in all situations. If you have any issues, please contact C3.
