Notes:

1. The student must have a minimum 2.0 GPA in all Music courses (Kirkwood & Coe) to complete the Bachelor Arts in Music.
2. The student is exempt from needing to take the Music Fundamentals courses for the BA in Music at Coe if the student has achieved a grade of "C" or better in Music Theory courses taken at Kirkwood.
3. The student must complete 3 *Writing Emphasis* courses at Coe. A grade of "C" or better is needed to meet this requirement.
4. The General Education Divisional Requirements at Coe College includes the following: 2-course credits in **Fine Arts Core**; 2-course credits in **Humanities**; 2-course credits in **Natural Sciences and Mathematics**; at least one Lab Science course; 2-course credits in **Social Sciences**. The above template assumes the Transfer Student has met Coe's Liberal Arts Core requirements with appropriate courses taken at Kirkwood CC.
5. Coe has a Diversity Across the Curriculum requirement, however, it can be satisfied with the required music history courses.
6. If the student wants to complete the secondary education minor at Coe, they would be well-served to take as many of the professional education courses as possible at Kirkwood.
7. Recommended courses for those pursuing music education are as follows:
 - a. Kirkwood's Educational Psychology/EDU 240: meets Coe's requirement of Educational Psychology and Development EDU 195
 - b. Kirkwood's Exceptional Persons/EDU 248 **and** Inclusions and Adaptation/EDU 129: these two courses together meet Coe's requirement of Exceptional Learners EDU 117
8. Completion of the secondary education minor might require a ninth semester for student teaching.
