Registration Tips for Coe College Students

*Required

- Qualifications*

Not a U.S. Citizen? Only U.S. Citizens may register and vote. Do **NOT** attempt to register if you are not a citizen.
- ID*

Do NOT use an out-of-state driver's license number.

Not from Iowa? Iowa law requires you to provide the last four digits of your Social Security Number if you do not have an Iowa driver's license or non-operator ID.

Self-explanatory. (Do not skip gender)
- Name*

Self-explanatory.
- Address*

- To register and be eligible to vote at your college address in Linn County, Iowa:** Use your Coe College address (1220 1ST Ave NE) and your residence hall. For example: 1220 1ST Ave NE Armstrong Hall, Cedar Rapids, IA 52402
 - To register and be eligible to vote in your home county in Iowa,** use your home address in Iowa. Add your college address in *"Where You Receive Mail."*
 - To register and be eligible to vote in your home state,** contact your State's Election Office.

Where should our office send your mail?

This can be your home address or college mailing address.

 - For example: 1220 1ST Ave NE GMU 1234, Cedar Rapids, IA 52402. **You MUST include your GMU or box number.**
- Previous

Tell us where you lived before attending college.

If changing your registration address from home to college, it is a good idea to inform your parents of the change.

Self-explanatory.
- Signature*

Read before signing. Do NOT attempt to register and vote in more than one state. Registration data is shared between states.
